

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Air Transportation: ARC/IATAN jet economy class, round trip from gateway city applicable on all IATAN and ARC carriers, based on the non-refundable fare. Tours must be fully paid for and tickets issued no later than 60 days before the tour's departure date. If you cancel or change your reservation for any reason after tickets have been issued, a cancellation fee of 100% of the ticket price will be charged by the airline. Fuel Surcharges: We will review the air costs approximately 65 days before departure and notify you of any changes in air fuel surcharges or taxes. Deviations: Deviation requests should be in writing and will incur an additional service fee plus any applicable fare increases.

Land Transportation and Transfers: By private deluxe motor coach.

Accommodations: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$2,000.00 (tour participants without a roommate will have to pay the single room surcharge). Hotels used are superior first class and deluxe category.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner daily. Coffee or tea included with breakfast only; all other beverages are extra.

Baggage: Subject to change, free baggage allowance is governed by the airline on which you are flying. Baggage allowance guidelines will be included in your final documents. Excess baggage will be charged at the established rates. Due to limited motor coach capacity we urge our tour members to carry only one bag per person. Porterage for one checked bag is included in the tour price. Excess baggage charges from the airlines and motor coaches are the passenger's responsibility and will be collected at time of handling.

Service Charges and Taxes: Those normally levied by hotels and restaurants are included and all departure taxes and tipping.

Not Included: Passport costs, and health documentation costs (when required); food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with regular table d'hote meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident, baggage and trip cancellation insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special services not specifically mentioned as included; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone and cable expenses, internet access, room service orders, etc.; transportation between hometown city and gateway city.

Insurance: Acting only as agents for suppliers, Wilcox World Travel and Tours, Div. of Wilcox Travel Agency, Inc., is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. For protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. We recommend Allianz Travel Insurance. Travel protection is available to all residents of the U.S. and Canada, and includes coverage for lost luggage, medical emergencies and more. Guests booking this tour have the option of purchasing cancellation protection in the event they need to cancel their trip after making their reservations. This optional Guest Protection may be requested at time of booking and fee included with initial payment. Details will be provided with written confirmation of your tour reservation.

Important Passport Information: A valid passport is required and must be obtained in person by each tour member at a local passport office. Passports must have an expiration date beyond May 2, 2020 in order to travel with this tour. If your expiration date is inside this date, you must renew your passport in order to participate.

VISA: A visa is not required for US citizens traveling to Israel.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$300.00 per person is required immediately. Installment payments are accepted and updated statements will be forwarded with each payment sent. The balance is due no later than 60 days prior to departure. Please check your statement for specific due dates. Tour conditions and airfares are subject to Governmental, ARC/IATAN, and airline regulation requirements in effect on the date of and during the tour. All airfares and land rates are quoted in US Dollars and are based on tariffs and cost in effect February, 2019 and are subject to change without notice. Land costs are based on group rates and final tour cost may be dependent on number of tour participants.

Guests with Disabilities: Please be aware that certain land tours may not be fully accessible to persons with disabilities. Wilcox World Travel and Tours must be notified of any special medical, physical or other requirements of passengers at the time of booking. Should a passenger require the assistance of another to make this tour, it is the responsibility of that passenger to arrange for a companion to provide the assistance at all times and for the entire duration of the tour. Day by Day Itinerary

DAY 1 - MONDAY, 10/21 - DEPART CLE FOR ROME

We begin our tour of a lifetime with a late morning departure from Cleveland to Chicago. We connect with other travelers in Chicago for our late afternoon departure for Rome via United Airlines. We are served dinner and breakfast on the flight before we arrive in Rome.

DAY 2 -TUESDAY, 10/22 - ROME/COLLOSEUM/ ROMAN FORUM/ARCH OF TITUS/MAMMERTIME DUNGEON/ ST. PETER'S IN CHAINS

We begin our tour of Rome upon our arrival and quickly discover the "glory that was Rome" as we tour famous landmarks like the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, and the Arch of Titus. We consider the suffering of the early church leaders when we visit the Mammertine Prison and remember how Paul wrote Philippians, 2 Timothy, and perhaps other epistles from this place. The sobering words of Paul in 2 Timothy 4:6-8 come to mind. We conclude our day with dinner and overnight at the beautiful Westin Excelsior hotel in Rome.



DAY 3 - WEDNESDAY, 10/23 - ROME/ VATICAN MUSEUM/ST PETER'S/CATACOMBS/

We begin our full-day of touring this great city by a stop at the Vatican Museum and the Sistene Chapel, where we see works by Rembrandt, Michelangelo & others. We marvel at the majesty of St. Peter's Basilica, then turn our attention to the Catacombs where early Christians hid because of persecution. Dinner at a local restaurant and overnight at the Westin hotel.

DAY 4- THURSDAY, 10/24 - PIAZZA VENEZIA/ VICTOR EMMANUEL MONUMENT/SPANISH STEPS/ PANTHEON/TREVI FOUNTAIN

Our last full day in Rome begins with the Statue of Moses at the church of Saint Peter's in Chains. We move from there to Piazza Venezia & pass the Victor Emmanuel monument before we reach the Spanish Steps, the Pantheon, and say "arrivederci" to Rome at the Trevi Fountain. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 5 - FRIDAY, 10/25 - CORINTH / PLAKA - KING GEORGE ATHENS

An early wake up call alerts us to our morning flight for Athens. Upon our arrival and after clearing customs, we head for Corinth and learn about "the Bema seat" (2 Cor. 5:10). After lunch we make our way to the old city, the Plaka, and reflect on the fascinating architecture of Greek society. The King George hotel in Athens provides comfortable accommodations and dinner for us this evening.

DAY 6 - SATURDAY, 10/26 - ATHENS - ACROPOLIS/PARTHENON/AGORA/HOUSE OF PARLIAMENT/ NETANYA

We spend the morning exploring the Acropolis and the magnificent Parthenon, the ancient temple and grandest landmark in the city of Athens. We stand on top of Mars' Hill and remember Paul's challenge to the Athenians in Acts 17:22-31. We pass the House of Parliament on the way to the airport for a late afternoon flight to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival at Ben-Gurion airport, we clear customs and head to the West Lagoon hotel in Natanya for a late dinner and overnight.



DAY 7 - SUNDAY, 10/27 - CAESAREA/ NAZARETH/BAPTISM AT GAN HAHLOSHA/BEIT SHEAN

After a relaxing breakfast, we head for the majestic seaport, Caesarea by the Sea, and turn our attention to the powerful influence of King Herod the Great on this land. We move on to Nazareth, where we recall the announcement of the angel, Gabriel, to Mary about the birth of Jesus (Luke 1:26-38). After lunch, we enjoy baptism at Gan Hashlosa, celebrating all that Jesus has accomplished for us. We conclude the day with a visit to Beit Shean before heading to Tiberias for dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Plaza hotel.

DAY 8 - MONDAY, 10/28 - BOATRIDE/ CAESAREA PHILIPPI/CAPERNAUM/MT OF BEATITUDES/ MAGDALA

Nothing is more beautiful than sunrise over the Sea of Galilee! We begin the day with a peaceful boat ride on the lake where Jesus performed many of His miracles. We drive up the Golan Heights to Caesarea Philippi, the picturesque location for the conversation between Peter and Jesus recorded

in Matthew 16. Following lunch we turn our attention to the ministry of our Lord described in the Gospels with a visit to the hometown of Jesus - Capernaum. Migdal, a thriving community at the time of our Lord, reveals to us the recent archeological discovery of a First Century synagogue, which Jesus likely visited. We remember the "Greatest Sermon ever Preached" with a visit to the Mount of Beatitudes before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 - TUESDAY, 10/29 - MT ARBEL/ MEGIDDO/MT GERAZIM/NABLUS/JERICHO/BETHANY

This morning, we say "so long" to the shores of the Sea of Galilee with a ride up Mt. Arbel, where the Crusaders experienced their final defeat at the hands of Saladin. We then head for Megiddo where we climb a tel and learn about 30 layers of civilization, as well as the final battle of this period of history. We turn our attention to sites in Samaria like Mt. Gerazim and Nablus, the location of Jacob's Well. We enjoy a late lunch at Jericho before we climb the tel and look down on the ruins of the oldest excavated city in the world. We conclude our day at Bethany, the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus before heading to Jerusalem where we enjoy dinner and overnight at the beautiful David Citadel Hotel.

DAY 10 - WEDNESDAY, 10/30 - TEMPLE MOUNT/POOLS OF BETHESDA/QUMRAN/EINGEDI/ MASADA/DEAD SEA

Today, we catch an early bus to the Temple Mount, home to the temples of Solomon and Herod. Today it's the location for the Dome of the Rock, the Mosque of Omar, originally built in the 7th Century and the Al Aqsa Mosque, used by Muslims for prayer. After the Temple Mount, we visit the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the lame man (John 5). We then head to the desert to enjoy a visit to Qumran, the location for the most significant archeological discovery of the 20th Century - the Dead Sea Scrolls. We move on to Ein Gedi, the desert oasis, where we recall the worship of David in Psalm 46. After lunch, we stop at Masada, where Jewish zealots met their fate at the hands of the Roman army. We conclude the day with a visit to the Dead Sea, where the adventurous can enjoy floating in the waters at the lowest place on earth. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight



DAY 11 - THURSDAY, 10/31 - HOLOCAUST MUSEUM/ISRAEL MUSEUM/BETHLEHEM/HERODIAN/ SHEPHERDS' FIELDS/CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY/ SHOPPING

We begin our day with a sobering visit to the Holocaust Museum, Yad Vashem, which reminds us of the atrocities of World War II. We move on to the Israel Museum where we enjoy a model of the City of Jerusalem in the 1st Century and some of the discoveries in the caves of Qumran. The Herodian is our next stop, the majestic man-made mountain outside of Bethlehem, which became the site for the grave of King Herod. After lunch, we move to the Shepherd's Fields where we reflect on the appearance of the angels to announce the birth of Christ to the shepherds (Luke 2:8-18). A visit to the Church of the Nativity concludes our focus on the incarnation of our Lord before we enjoy shopping in Bethlehem. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.



DAY 12 - FRIDAY, 11/1- GARDEN TOMB/ GORDON'S CALVARY/MT OF OLIVES/GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE/VIA DOLOROSA/CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHER/OLD CITY/FAREWELL DINNER

We begin our last day in Jerusalem with a moving visit to Gordon's Calvary and the Garden Tomb, where we celebrate communion and remember the death and resurrection of our Lord. We then descend the slopes of the Mt. of Olives and retrace the steps of Jesus on that first Palm Sunday before arriving at the Garden of Gethsemane where He agonized about his coming crucifixion. We retrace the steps of Jesus on the way to the cross as we make our way along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. We enjoy lunch in the Old City, then conclude our time in Jerusalem with free time for shopping before a farewell dinner at the Ambassador Hotel in preparation for a late-night departure from Tel Aviv aboard United Airlines

DAY 13 - SATURDAY, 11/2 - ARRIVE USA

Our non-stop flight to Newark provides dinner and breakfast in route before we arrive in the U.S., clear customs and make our connecting flights filled with memories for a lifetime and renewed passion to study the Scriptures.
